I am confused the by stats that say the aperture is wider on the SX40 as some reviewers have said that they both the same at 35X zoom. If you wanted to shoot at a particular ISO and shutter speed, then the SX40 could still do so in slightly darker conditions. If your subject is moving, however, a shorter shutter speed may be required, so then the SX40 may be the better choice.
